### **TITLE I: DISCIPLINE IN THE SCHOOL**

Considering the fact that educational establishments where order and discipline prevail have good conditions conducive to the intellectual, physical and moral development of young people. In order to develop a spirit of tolerance and harmony within the school, you, as a student of the "Crucible of Knowledge", must observe to the letter the rules of respect for order and those of politeness below.

**Article 1** : you must **be punctual** (always arrive on time at school)

**Attended** (never be absent from class)

**Worker** (always doing homework)

**Article 2**: You must wear the prescribed clothing

**Article 3**: Avoid wearing extravagant clothes (strange, unreasonable...)

- a) Avoid using rudeness (using offensive words)
- b) Avoid making insults (using offensive, hurtful, humiliating words...)
- c) You must have a decent outfit:
- d) Avoid fanciful hairstyles (abnormal, imaginative...)

**Articles 4**: You must have a respectful attitude towards your elders, your classmates and the youngest ones.

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**Article 5:** you must never switch to school:

- ✓ You enter class in order and leave the class in the same way.
- ✓ You always line up in order of size.
- ✓ Never wait for someone to come and align you, it's the size that determines your place in the row.

**Article 6:** You must avoid climbing and walking on tables and benches in class, even running between them.

**Article 7:** Do not draw on benches, tables, walls or write on them. Leave the walls of buildings clean, don't climb them and don't lean against them either.

**Article 8:** Do not yawn loudly (with noise) at school and spit on the ground.

**Article 9:** During recess, you must completely free the classroom.

**Article 10:** Ask to speak or always wait your turn before speaking.

**Article 11:** Never extend your arm to your superior (Director, Master...).

**Article 12:** Always show your notebooks at home: checkbook, of the days... to your parents, either for them to sign or for them to read them.

**Article 13:** You must arrange the furniture of the class well: the benches and tables must be tidy or aligned.

**Article 14:** Avoid taking justice into your own hands; complain to your master if you have a problem with your classmate and avoid beating on him.

## TITLE II: HEALTH PRESERVATION.



The health of the school community is the concern of all its members without exception, where the strict cleanliness of everyone's body and clothing guarantees health for all, without also discarding the cleanliness of the environment.

In addition, in order to prevent the same members of the community mentioned above from accident risks, the spirit of safety must be developed.

**Article 15:** You must arrive at school in a perfectly clean state:

- ✓ You must wash your whole body with clean water and soap.
- ✓ You need to comb or shave your hair so that it doesn't get tousled or curly. Girls must do small braids without streaks.
- ✓ You must brush your teeth with a toothbrush and toothpaste.
- ✓ You must clean your nails or trim them short so that they do not keep dirt.
- ✓ You must wash the outfit twice a week: Saturday and Wednesday evening, to wear it clean the following days.
- ✓ You have to make sure every day that they are free of oil stains, lollipop stains, and bic ink stains.

**Article 16:** You must make sure that the whole school is always clean:

- a) Don't throw paper on the ground, anything in the classroom, in the yard and behind buildings;
- b) Tell your classmate to immediately pick up anything he had just thrown on the ground.
- c) To keep the floor of the classroom, yard and behind buildings clean, pick up any papers or objects that may be lying around, or sweep the floor after watering.
- d) Throw everything you pick up in the garbage and empty it at night before you leave school.
- e) Always leave the toilet clean, i.e. aim for the hole before letting go of your stool and then, with water, flush out the urine.

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**Articles 17:** You must avoid any sudden movement:

- a. Avoid games that cause sweat to come out. It will wet your outfit as you wore it being clean; because of this sweat your outfit will get dirty and will also release odours;
- b. Avoid crazy shopping at school;
- c. Refuses dangerous games;
  - Hand games,
  - Games with sharp or pointed objects,
  - The rushes.
- d. The games during which:
  - We throw rocks;
  - We're skipping rope;
  - We climb...

**Article 18:** Never bring dangerous objects to school: needles, blades, knives, nails, forks...

**Article 19:** Do not suck your finger; do not put sharp or non-pointed objects in your mouth, nostrils or ears.

**Article 20:** Refuses to fight at school, even on the road or at home.



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
